**PROJECT REQUIREMENTS:**

St. Peter's Seminary, an intriguing building of more than 100 years was in dire need of having its windows that leaked air and water replaced. The challenge was to replace the windows, predominantly in dormitories, with a high performance, state of the art window, while not compromising the beauty of this historical, majestic structure. The architect originally planned to replace the existing double hungs with similar windows, so as not to distort the harmonious architecture of this impressive building.
